CONTRABAND LIST

The following items are deemed to be contraband for ALL residents and possession of any listed item listed is prohibited while residing at the CTS-Russell Community Center. Any item found will be confiscated and disposed of.

Non-issued locks	Paint	Cellular phones
Video tapes/DVD's (including burned dvds, cds)	Alcohol, narcotics, or any controlled substance	Possession of money over \$75.00 (Applies to all non-working residents)
Any item considered dangerous or flammable; any form of glue	Luggage/duffle/bags of any kind	Flash drives (thumb drives for computer)
Sewing kits or items	Personal fans or heaters	Incense or candles
Cameras of any kind (video, still, game devices, etc.)	Tools (unless needed for employment)	Any food item not defined on property list (microwaveable pasta items)
Cardboard boxes, laundry baskets, suitcases, plastic tubs, etc.	Drinks in living/sleeping areas (unless in cup with lid) Food items in living/sleeping areas	Pornographic material such as nude pictures
DVD players, VCRs, computers (of any kind); extension cords	Any excess property (according to limits on personal property)	Game systems not transferred directly from another DOC Institution
Devices used for gambling; including playing cards	Bleach in any form	Tobacco products not sold in CTS store/vending machines. Such as loose tobacco for making cigarettes and rolling papers.
Knives or weapons of any kind	Food stamp cards	Starch, baby powder, or any other powders, aerosol, body sprays
Glass containers of any kind	Ipods; MP3 players	Improperly stored items
Personal pillows	Extension cords	Hair dyes or permanents
Gang related items: Signs, pictures, or paraphernalia depicting gang related activity; red, green, or blue bandanas. Both pant legs and socks need to be at the same level. No mail or literature depicting gang symbols or activities may be in a resident's possession or property	Mouthwash, cold medicine, or any over the counter medication that contains alcohol and can be consumed	Any solution or solvent thought to alter a urine screen such as vinegar, cleaners, pills, denture cleaner, or sure gel
